Syria's Christians Search for Peace



## **Renew Wellbeing**

Renew Wellbeing is the name of the overarching organisation that is helping churches around the country to replicate the renew wellbeing cafe concept with help and funding until Sept 2017 from Cinnamon Network.

Renew Wellbeing helps churches open spaces of welcome and inclusion in partnership with mental health teams to improve mental and emotional wellbeing.

Renew spaces are simple cafe style spaces run by local churches where hobbies and activities are shared or co-produced. Each cafe space is attached to a quiet room or prayer space where inner habits of wellbeing are shared. Each church partners with a mental health professional from the local council to ensure good inclusive practices for safe spaces where its OK not to be OK can be sustained.
