Short term mission with OM

Can you see yourself bringing the Good News of Jesus to children in Moldova? How about reaching out to the Ifugao tribal communities in the Philippines? If you are looking to serve between one week and six months then a short term outreach with OM is for you. Meet new friends, learn new skills, serve God.

Operation Mobilisation have opportunities throughout the year for individuals and groups to join with local OM teams and share in making the message of the love of Christ known by word or action. You'll be part of an international team led by our long term workers in the country. It is a unique opportunity to enjoy fellowship with Christians from around the world, as a fresh expression of the global dimension of the Church.

One such opportunity is Global Village, held in Keswick from 21-27 July, is designed to motivate Christians of all ages to engage with the Great Commission. It is an innovative and interactive project that allows teens and adults to go on a 1-hour simulated mission trip. Guest Events

There is an endless array of events a church could run to which invitations could be made. Here are some suggestions and resources that may also spark ideas of your own.



A tea dance: A perfect afternoon for an older generation – with a talk on ‘God’s Great Dance’ or ‘Following His Footsteps.’

Helping your kids grow up right: For parents with wise advice on discipline, self-esteem and growing up with God as a one-off. Or the first session of Parent Talk the Teenage Years or Parent Talk the Primary Years.

Supper parties: Hosts invite two or three others from the church and all invite guests. Use one of the TableTalk sessions to promote conversation.

Parents and little ones: Hold a Messy Church afternoon.



Guest artist: A concert, theatre production or comedy evening from someone like Abby Scott, Jacob Lloyd and comedy duo, The Monks.

Remembrance 100

One hundred years ago King George V led the nation in a national day of prayer for peace on 4th August 1918. One hundred days later the war ended. Churches across the UK will be praying for peace in the 100 days before Remembrance Sunday from 4 August to 11 November.

To help you pray through the 100 days and to consider what it means to be a peacemaker, HOPE has compiled a 144-page anthology of prayers and stories called 100 Days of Peace and Hope written by Christians across the denominations, living and working in different contexts and countries.

They are also providing churches with a giveaway, pocket-sized booklet called Silence to use at Remembrance services and to reflect on life's big issues. Copies of both books will be available to order in June.

On the HOPE website you will find numerous resources including:

- Ideas and prayers for 100 days of peace from 4 August to 11 November 2018.
- A guide on how to hold a peace party for your community
- A World War 1 Commemoration Order of Service
- A short video based on Revelation 21:3-4, verses about peace, to show at your Remembrance Day event
