

## **Godly Play**

Godly Play can help you see and do things differently

"In most religious education children are told who God is.

In Godly Play children discover who God is."

Godly play is an approach based on Montessori principles – we respond to the child's request to 'help me do



it by myself.' This puts the teacher in the role of spiritual supporter or guide who fully accepts that each child has his or her own relationship with God already. The teaching takes place in different ways at the same time: it is multimodal and multi-sensory.
