A Mile with Jesus

Thy Kingdom Come 2019 included a prayer walk along the Shropshire Way. On the walk Christians were seeking God to find out 'what is the unique thing that God wants to do in and through Shropshire?

Neighbourhood Prayer Watch aims to see every postcode area in the UK with at least one congregation commit to prayer walking some of the streets in their postcode.



Within the guide there are three parts: Part I : Preparing to Prayer Walk and an A to Z guide of places you might come across. We have provided some prayer points for each one. Some of you may be walking in more rural areas, others in more residential areas, others around Towns and Cities. There is something here for all of these. As residential roads and streets may make up a significant part of your walk, we have provided a special section for praying for streets at the beginning.

Part II: We have provided some inspirational scriptures that you may want to pray over streets, or places or to aid you in prayer.

Part III: Some churches may wish to take this vision, further, so we provide five suggestions of how you could use this to do an outreach after your prayer walks.
