## Prayer Ramble

Based around the Granville Heritage Trail in North East Telford this prayer ramble gives an opportunity to prayerfully explore the industrial heritage of Telford. All the benefits of the Industrial Revolution (which we enjoy today) came at great cost, both in huge environmental damage and to human beings. This trail gives us the opportunity to see and pray into the damage, but also to give thanks for some of the wonderful things that happened at the time and that we benefit from now. We will also be able to pray at other significant places along the way. There are also several identifiable former places of worship on the route that were established to reach the workers as settlements grew.
